The new Millmerran Multipurpose Health Service facility will provide improved access to quality healthcare to support the community for generations to come.

Part of the more than \$1 billion Building Rural and Remote Health Program (BRRHP), the new Millmerran Multipurpose Health Service (MPHS) facility is under construction and scheduled to be complete in the first half of 2025.

The new development is funded by the Queensland Government's Building Rural and Remote Health Program, which is dedicated to enhancing healthcare services in regional and remote communities.

Due to its age and increasing maintenance burden, the existing MPHS facility will be demolished upon completion of the new build.

Existing services will continue uninterrupted while construction is underway.
