



Maureen was a very competent and popular lady Golfer that held associate committee positions and dominated the ladies' championships throughout the eighties and nineties being A Grade champion almost every year in that period, also winning many district events as well. She was a true Champion and very humble in her golfing success.

Terry Bright our iconic barman: There have been many people involved in the evolution of the Millmerran Golf Club but none so memorable as Terry. He was employed as the club's barman and general dogs' body in the eighties and nineties, Terry was not only an icon at the club but also known far and wide in the golfing fraternity. He was an extremely social and entertaining character who devoted much of his life to the clubhouse and running it. He was a true professional in his position and could work a packed bar while smoking five cigarettes and drinking three beers and be in many conversations from one end of the bar to the other, much to the dismay of some local members but, Terry did push the

boundaries at time. If Terry wasn't in a drama, he would create one, he loved a performance and a song, (Frank Sinatra New York New York was a favorite).

I doubt if anybody could outperform Terry's commitment. His contribution to the club went far above and beyond what was required, his social personality was a beneficial input to the club during his years as barman, to the people who knew him, his charismatic persona will be a lasting memory. And everybody will have many stories of their own experiences with Terry. For some it's the old saying what happened at the club stays at the club.

On his retirement due to ill health of his mother Stella, he was awarded Life Membership. As Terry said: Golfers are a funny lot.

Millmerran Power Small Grants Program

Introduction

The Millmerran Community Small Grants Program has been funded by 7 main companies that worked at the station for the 2024 major outage. It is aimed to support and empower local initiatives through the provision of financial assistance. With a total fund of \$34,700, the program aims to foster community development, promote social inclusion, and enhance the quality of life for residents. Each grant awarded under this program will be up to a maximum of \$5,000.

Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the Millmerran Community Small Grants Program, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Applicants must be community groups, or non-profit organizations based in Millmerran.
- The project or initiative must directly benefit the Millmerran community.
- The project must align with one or more of the program's focus areas: community development, social inclusion, education, health, environment, arts, and culture.
- Applicants must provide a detailed budget and plan for the use of the grant.

Application Process

The application process for the Millmerran Community Small Grants Program consists of the following steps:

Step 1: Application Submission - Complete the application form, providing all necessary information. Email adminmill@genuity.com.au to obtain the form.

Step 2: Review & Decision – Applications will be reviewed by a Millmerran Power to ensure they meet the eligibility criteria and align with the program's objectives. Successful applicants will be notified of the decision and the amount of the grant awarded.

Step 4: Fund Disbursement - Funds will be disbursed to successful applicants upon agreement of terms and conditions.

Step 5: Final Report – Upon completion of the project, recipients will submit a final report detailing the outcomes and impact of the grant.





Rich Fruit Cake

Ingredients

10 oz Plain Flour 8 oz Butter 7 oz Brown Moist Sugar 4 large Eggs

2 oz Almonds chopped 1—1 1/2 lb Dried Fruit

4 oz Glace Cherries 2-4 oz Mixed Peel (optional)

Grated rind of 1 Orange 1 tbsp Black Treacle
1/4 tsp each of Nutmeg, Cinnamon & Mixed Spice

1/4 tsp Bi-Carb Soda 1/2 tsp Salt

2 tbsp of Brandy, Rum or Sherry

Method

Prepare a 9 inch cake tin by lining with a thickness of baking paper. Warm your mixing bowl and beaters. Place butter and sugar and grated rinds in the bowl, beat at minimum speed until ingredients have combined, then increase speed. Cream until light and fluffy, turn off, add treacle at a low speed and add eggs one at a time, thoroughly beating each. Reduce speed to minimum, tip in all the sifted flour, salt, spices and soda, then the fruit and nuts. Switch off as soon as ingredients are incorporated and turn out into the prepared cake tin.

Bake in a slow oven (300 degrees F) for 1 hour, then slightly reduce heat (275 degrees F) for 2 1/4 hours. When cake is cold, turn upside down pierce with a skewer in several places, and pour on the Brandy, Rum or Sherry. When this has soaked in, turn the cake the right way up, wrap in greaseproof paper and place in air-tight tin. Note—prepare cake at the beginning of December.

"I AM" God

If you have a red-letter Bible (meaning that the words Jesus spoke are in red print) you might notice something very interesting about the term "Alpha and Omega" - a phrase written only 4 times in the Bible & all of them in the book of Revelation. The 4 occasions are found in Rev 1:8, 1:11, 21:6 & 22:13. Now if we look them up in our red-letter edition of the Bible, we'll find that 3 of them are in red

& 1 of them is not. Why is that? Because Jesus only spoke 3 of them, but it is God that speaks in Rev 21:6. Now, the word "Alpha" is the first letter of the Greek alphabet & "Omega" is the last letter of the Greek alphabet, which is why each time this phrase is used, it is followed with "beginning and ending", or "the first and the last". But the interesting thing is that all things can only begin once & all things can only end once - never twice!

So, how can Jesus be the beginning & the end, and God also be the beginning & the end?? How? Because they are the same being!! I love how the Bible never contradicts but always encourages us to have Thus saith the Lord the King of Israel, faith. Jesus is God and God is Jesus. Jesus is God in the flesh, which is best explained in Mat 1:23 "Behold, a virgin shall be with child, and shall bring forth a son, and they shall call his name Emmanuel, which being interpreted is, God with us.". What a gift Jesus the Messiah is!

Isaiah 44:6 and his redeemer the Lord of hosts; I am the first, and I am the last; and beside me there is no God.

Because of Christmas!

Because of Christmas I know God loves me! Not everyone grew up in homes or environments where they felt very loved, celebrated or cheered on. So, we all have different reference points in life but, whatever our experience, each of us have a God shaped place within us. And that place can only be filled by God's love.

I pray that what we're sharing together this month resonates in your heart. As you read, I encourage you to believe and to receive the great love the Father has for you.

If you've dealt with rejection or feelings of loneliness where you don't feel loved, don't feel accepted. To people around you, you might seem okay but on the inside you just don't feel loved...you feel that sense of rejection.

There is one who loves you, has always loved you. How can you know? How can you be sure?

John 3:16 assures us, For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. In giving Jesus, God didn't just say, I love you. He showed us. He proved to the whole world, to everybody that would ever live, for all time, I love these people above all, and I am willing to do anything and pay anything to get them and save them...and He did.

God loves you!

Go onto verse 17, God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him. When we understand this verse, it's clear God isn't condemning or judging us. Yet how many ministers and churches have preached condemnation trying to shame people into compliance. That's not God! God does not want you burdened by shame, condemnation or guilt.

God sent Jesus into the world not to condemn us, not to shame or make us feel guilty. No, He's not pleased with sin. God's not going to tell you sin's okay but He's not going to condemn you over it either. He wants help you get free of it. You might say, but you don't know what I've done! Well, I'd have say, you don't know the power of God's love or just how much he loves you. 1 John 4:9-10 tells us, God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. ¹⁰ This is real love—not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as a sacrifice to take away our sins.

It's not about whether you are loving Him enough or loving Him the right way? It's so easy, because of our own human nature, for us to fall into a religious mindset of works in trying to earn or deserve God's love. God said it's not about

Jesus didn't come to start a religion or even a denomination. He came bringing an invitation...an invitation He shares in Matthew 11:27-30.

I like this best in the Message Bible, Jesus resumed talking to the people, but now tenderly. "The Father has given me all these things to do and say. This is a unique Father-Son operation, coming out of Father and Son intimacies and knowledge. No one knows the Son the way the Father does, nor the Father the way the Son does. But I'm not keeping it to myself; I'm ready to go over it line by line with anyone willing to listen. 28-30 "Are you tired? Worn out?" Burned out on religion? Come to me. Get away with me and you'll recover your life. I'll show you how to take a real rest. Walk with me and work with me—watch how I do it. Learn the unforced rhythms of grace. I won't lay anything heavy or ill-fitting on you. Keep company with me and you'll learn to live freely and lightly."

Wow! What an invitation!

Do you see that God loves us just as much as He loves Jesus? Can that be true...that the Father Ireally does loves us just as much as He loves Jesus? Yes, it is. He said so. Read the conversation between Jesus and the Father recorded in John 17. Notice verse 23 where Jesus is speaking, I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love

My friend, you are so very deeply loved! This Christmas time, I pray that you would experience for yourself the love of God and you would truly know how deeply loved you are. His love for you is real and unchanging.


